Home Geothermal System Maintenance

- Time of the year again to INSPECT YOUR SYSTEM!
 - Heat exchangers, radiators, valves, controllers, filters, etc.
 - Heat exchangers (forced air systems) do have a service life - change them out before they fail.
 - Aný signs of corrosion? Seek advice from Del!
- > COLD HOUSE?
 - Your geowater FLOW could be restricted!
 - Have your pipes/orifice inspected for blockage. Water reacts with system metals to build corrosive deposits around valves, orifices, etc.
 - AIR BUBBLES in radiators can also impede flow of hot water. Bleed your system!

ANY FLOW RESTRICTION IN YOUR SYSTEM CAN IMPEDE THE EFFICIENCY OF YOUR HEAT EXCHANGER!








Approved Geothermal Water Use

Boise Warm Springs Water District


(Approved piping network for home heating & domestic use)




Unapproved Geothermal Water Use

Boise Warm Springs Water District


(Unapproved piping network for home heating & other geothermal hot water use)

Total Gallons Pumped - 5 Yr Trend



2024 Revenue & Expenditures

> REVENUE

- Actual: \$472,436.08
- Budget: \$532,575.72
 Difference: \$60,139.64 (mostly due to Ag Lab metered income shortfall)

> EXPENSES

- Actual: \$322,987.55
- Budget: \$374,240.64
 Difference: \$51,253.09

2025 Budget - 3% Increase

- > Projected Revenue (w/ rate increase)
 - Budget \$547,566.27
- > Projected Expenditures (includes MRP loan payment)
 - Budget \$546,162.00

Mainline Replacement Project UPDATE

Project Completed!

- ~6400 total feet of mainline replaced - including 1520ft of extension!
- (10) 12-in valves replaced/installed!
- (8) 6-inch valves replaced/installed!





Project Completed!


- (91) Service lines replaced!
- (91) Water meters installed (for water usage tracking)!
- 2948 feet of service piping installed!
- Relocated PRV valve which allowed approx.
 10 homes to have private PRVs removed, thus making the system operate more efficiently with lower maintenance concerns.







Mainline Replacement Project



MRP Wrap up!

- Total cost: ~ \$3.25M
- ~16 weeks of construction in 2023
- ~7 weeks of construction in 2024
- ~18M gallons of Boise City geowater used
- System performance drastically improved
 - higher system pressure observed
 - decrease in gallons pumped (~22M gallons saved from 2023)
 - elimination of leaks along Warm Springs Ave.
- System service life extended well beyond another 50 years.
